1926.104	Are lifelines secured above the point of operation to an anchorage or structural member capable of supporting a minimum-dead weight of 5,400 pounds			
1926.104	Are safety harness lanyards a minimum of ½ inch nylon, or equivalent?			
1926.104	Are safety harness lanyards worn by employees a maximum length to provide for a fall of no greater than 6 feet?			
1926.104	Do safety harness worn by employees have a nominal breaking strength of 5,000 pounds?			
1926.105	Are safety nets provided when workplaces are more than 25 feet above the ground or other surfaces where the use of ladders, scaffolds, catch platforms, temporary floors, safety lines or safety belts is impractical?			
1910.132	Have all employees wearing PPE been trained to appropriately wear the required devices and know the limitations of each?
